"Seismic Public Meeting Notice"

Dawson Geophysical will be conducting seismic operations, using the shot / test hole method within areas both East and West of U.S. Highway 71, East of Interstate I-49, East and West of State Hwy. # 10 and also on the East and West side of the RRABB levee between the towns or communities of Bunkie and Lebeau, Louisiana and more specifically defined within the following Township and Ranges.

A seismic shot hole test will be performed during the month of October, 2017 for the purpose of establishing parameters for the seismic project. The seismic survey field operations should commence on or around Thursday October 26, 2017, drilling operations around the month of December, 2017 or January, 2018 and data acquisition around the months of April/May, 2018. The all-inclusive seismic field operations should be completed around the month of July, 2018. The commencement of these operations is contingent upon receiving all regulatory permits in a timely manner.
