Effective July 1, 2002, original receipts for materials indicating taxes paid must be provided to the officer at the time of inspection of all homemade boats. Applicants for inspection of boats other than homemade must provide proof of ownership and/or the Court Order/Affidavit signed by a Justice of the Peace at the time of inspection. All Inspected boats must be titled.
